

July 2018 Practice Quiz Answers

- 1. B 1/10 A-39 Snap :25** The result of the play is Team A in possession at the end of the down. However, Team A is not in legal possession and the ball belongs to Team B at the spot of the recovery. Team B will enforce the penalty for offside at the dead ball spot because the ball belongs to team B there. Also, technically, there is a violation for illegal touching that is cancelled because of the accepted penalty for the live ball foul. [6.1.6.a] [6.1.2.c.1] [6.1.8]
- 2. A 1/10 B-30 Ready :40** The result of the play is the ball declared dead beyond the line to gain in Team A possession. Team B's touching of the ball precedes possession; This causes the ball to become dead by touching a player who is OOB. Therefore this is a forward fumble OOB by Team A. The ball will be returned to the spot of the fumble, and the game clock will start on the RFP signal. [5.1.1][5.2.3.a][2.11.4.a][7.2.4.b.1][3.3.2.e.2]
- 3. A 1/10 B-47 Ready** The result of the play is the ball declared dead short of the LTG. Dead Ball UNS foul by B54. This foul causes the GC to stop immediately. Because the GC is under a minute in the 4th period, this penalty has an option for a 10 second subtraction. [9.2.1] [3.4.4.a]"
- 4. B 1/10 A-31 Snap :25** The result of the play is a kick out of bounds which was untouched by Team B. Team has committed multiple fouls. 1. KOB 2. Illegal Batting - batting the ball forward. 3. KCI - A88 interfered with B10's opportunity to catch the kick. The best option for team B would be to accept the penalty for KCI and decline the others. The penalty is enforced 15 yards from the spot of the foul, A-46. [6.4.1] [6.2.1] [9.4.1]
- 5. B 1/10 B-33 Snap :25** The result of the play is Free Kick recovered by Team A in legal possession. There are 2 live ball fouls during the down. KCI along with an illegal bat. The KCI penalty will be enforced from the B-25 at the ball location where the foul occurred. The illegal bat would be declined. [6.1.3.a.3] [6.5.1.b] [9.4.1.c] [6.4.1.c.exc]
- 6. B 1/10 B-1 Snap :25** Team B intercepts the pass inside the 5-yard line and his original momentum takes him into the endzone. Since he fumbled the ball out of bounds in the field of play, the ""momentum"" exception applies and the end of the run becomes the B-2. The foul occurred during the fumble, so the basic spot is the end of the related run, the B-2. Since the team in possession fouled in front of the basic spot, we will enforce from the basic spot; 1/2 the distance to the goal. [8.5.1.exception] [10.2.2.c]
- 7. A 1/10 B-49 Snap :25** A9's pitch is a backward pass because it was first touched by A22 behind the spot of the pitch. The accidental kicking of the ball is not a foul. The status of the ball is still a backward pass as it goes out of bounds, even though it eventually becomes dead ahead of the spot of the pass. The ball belongs to the passing team at this spot, A-36. Enforce the 15-yard penalty for the dead ball personal foul from this spot. Next play will start on the snap. [2.19.2.a][7.2.4.a][3.3.2.d.2]

8. **B 1/10 B-40 Snap :25** There are two forward passes during this play. Therefore, A34's pass is an illegal forward pass. The contact by B25 is legal because defensive pass interference is only possible during a legal forward pass. Team B will decline the illegal forward pass penalty and take the result of the play, [7.3.2.d] [7.3.8.a]
9. **A 2/20 A-45 Ready :25** A88 is blocking downfield prior to a pass that is first touched beyond the neutral zone. A forward pass has crossed the neutral zone, when it first strikes the ground, a player, official or anything beyond the neutral zone. There is no foul for illegal touching since A75 did not intentionally touch the ball. [2.19.3.a] [7.3.8] [7.3.11]
10. **A 4/G B-1/2 Ready** The result of the play is a TD. Replay reversed the on-field ruling of TD. Because the correct ruling would not have stopped the GC, the Referee will set the game clock to :12 seconds then subtract 10 seconds from the game clock, and the clock will start on the ready for play signal. With only :02 seconds remaining after the subtraction there is only time for 1 play. [12.3.6.c] [3.2.5]
11. **B 1/10 B-30 Snap :25** The result of the play is a TD. Live ball foul for BBW on A65. A65 is now restricted from BBW from the side once the player leaves the tackle box. The block in the back is legal from B29 as long as it is above the waist and it is in attempt to legally recover the fumble. The clipping penalty will be enforced according to 3 and 1 principle. Normally if live ball fouls by both teams are reported to the referee then the fouls offset and replay the down. Because team B had not fouled prior to gaining possession (clean hands), Team B may refuse offsetting fouls and decline the penalty for Team A's BBW. They will retain possession after enforcement of its clipping foul.[9-1-6-a-1] [9-3-6 exc. 3] [9-1-5] [10-1-4 exc. 1]
12. **B 1/10 A-44 Snap :25** The result of the play is an onside kick ruled dead with Team A in legal possession at the end of the down. A11 commits a foul for BBW and an illegal block before his team is eligible to touch the kick. A11 also commits an illegal touching violation. Since Team A is in legal possession, the enforcement spot for Team A penalties would be from the previous spot. So, Team B will decline the penalties and invoke their privilege to put the ball in play at the spot of the violation. [6.1.3.a] [9.1.6.c] [6.1.12] [6.1.3.b]
13. **B 1/10 B-29 Snap :25** B3 gives a valid catch signal and muffs the ball. Because a teammate makes the catch, and not the signaler, Team B does not get the ball at the B-25. Instead the ball will belong to Team B where it was first touched by B3, the B-14. Enforce the dead ball personal foul 15 yards from the succeeding spot. [6.5.1.a] [6.5.1.b] [10.2.2.a]
14. **B 1/10 B-25 Snap :40** Although the fair catch signal is outside of the B-25, the fair catch is made inside the B-25. Therefore, the ball will be placed at the B-25. Play clock goes to :40 after a free kick [6.5.1]

15. **B Try A-3 UTD :25** The result of the play is a TD. Live ball foul for OH in Team A's EZ. Fouls by the non-scoring Team in which a play ends in a TD (not on a Try), 5-10 yard penalties are declined by Rule. [10.2.5.a.2] *Note, something to chew on, since there are 2 rules that are in conflict with each other [10.2.5.a.2 and 10.2.2.b Exc] and there is no clear answer which supersedes the other, would you consider giving the offended Teams coach both options and have them choose the enforcement option? Decline the OH and take the result of the play with the TD, or take the Safety by penalty and get the ball?
16. **B 1/10 B-40 Snap :25** B3 signals for a fair catch and subsequently catches the ball inside the 25 yard line. According to the updated penalty statement for KCI, "For a foul on a free kick play behind the B-25-yard line against a player who has given a valid fair catch signal: Penalize from the B-25". [6.4.1] [6.5.1]
17. **A 3/2 50 Ready :25** A44 has lost his eligibility to touch the ball when he went out of bounds. His teammate, A88 touching the ball does not restore his eligibility. Therefore A44 commits a foul for illegal touching of a pass. There are live ball fouls by both teams that will offset. Replay the down.
18. **A 4/8 A-40 Snap :25** The result of the play is a kick dead in possession of Team B following a legal SK. Live ball fouls by both teams are reported to the Referee. DH for a pull and shoot, Team A player going OOB and returning inbounds during a scrimmage kick down. IBB as well by the receiving Team. When live ball fouls by both teams are reported to the Referee, the fouls offset and the down is repeated. The 10-1-4 exc does not apply because all Team B fouls are not governed by postscrimmage kick rules. The game clock will start on the snap following a legal kick down. [10.1.4][6.3.12][9.3.4.d][9.3.6][10.2.3][AR 10.2.3.VII][3.3.2.d.8]
19. **A 1/10 A-47 Snap :40** Because A9 runs outside the tackle box, there is no foul for roughing the kicker. But there is a foul for targeting. The 15 yard penalty will be enforced from the previous spot with an automatic 1st down. B37 is disqualified from the game. [9.1.4][9.1.16]
20. **A FK A-25 FLT :25** The Result of the play is Team A in legal possession of the free kick at the end of the down. There is a live ball for for illegal batting of a loose ball forward by Team A. There is no foul for KCI because of the muff following an invalid signal by the Team B player. The enforcement spot will be the previous spot because the ball does not belong to Team B.
